

Mission Appeal for Kabale Diocese, Uganda (June 24-25th)

Kabale Diocese is one of the 19 dioceses in Uganda located in the southwestern corner of the country — about 280 miles from the capital city of Kampala. We serve a population of about 1.8 million people, and 800,000 are Roman Catholic. The vast majority of the people we serve are located in rural underserved, and mostly remote areas of the country. Most critical among the challenges faced is healthcare. The leading causes of death in Uganda include neonatal disorders, HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, lower respiratory infections, diarrheal diseases, congenital defeats, heart disease, stroke, road injury, and malnutrition.

The purpose of the appeal is to seek financial support toward the development of a hospital for the rural poor — Our Lady of Good Health Hospital Rushoroza. Through the gracious generosity of many, we have managed to complete the initial phase - outpatient department, minor operating room, medical surgical ward, and small delivery/maternity unit. We are transitioning into the next phase for which we are seeking assistance, a phase that comprises of a children's ward, dental, ophthalmology, radiology, medical laboratory units, and expansion on the emergency room, operating room, maternity unit, and ambulance services. Our one and only ambulance is 16 years old and almost beyond repair.

We are also seeking assistance to support our long-term Kabale Diocese Orphaned and Vulnerable Children Program. Through our foster home care program, we provide outreach support to orphaned children, the vast majority of whom have lost both parents and are left all alone to fend for themselves. We provide them with shelter, school tuition, clothing, and healthcare. We are currently supporting 540 children out of well over 20,000 greatly in need to help. Additionally, although we are eternally grateful for the gift of vocations, currently 78 major seminarians and 820 catechist, we face a mounting challenge of their training and formation costs - \$400 per year for one seminarian, and \$150 per year for one catechist in training.

Any measure of outreach help will be greatly appreciated.

God Put the Wiggles in Children

Family with young children are welcome at St. Matthias. If you are a parent with a child — Relax! God put the wiggle in children don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house — as ALL ARE WELCOME. If you feel comfortable doing so, sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on in the sanctuary, they tire of seeing the backs of others' heads. Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, deacon, and ministers. This helps them to grow in understanding and feel part of the celebration.

Sing the songs, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you. If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in the house of worship. The presence of children is a gift to the Church.
