Calling Children for Sacraments

Sacraments are rituals in the Church that use visible signs and symbols to impart an invisible reality - God's love for His people. The first sacrament we receive is **Baptism**. Next, children are invited to experience God's saving love and forgiveness in the sacrament of

Reconciliation, and later in the same year, Jesus' presence in the Body and Blood of Holy **Eucharist**.

As a young person grows and matures in their life and faith, the next sacrament they are invited to receive is **Confirmation** when the Holy Spirit descends upon them and God gifts them with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit to be strengthened for the many obstacles of life.

If your child is currently in 1st grade, they may be eligible to begin preparing for the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist in the fall. Likewise, if your child is currently in 8th grade, they may be eligible to begin preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation in the fall. And if your child has not yet been baptized, we can help with that too!
