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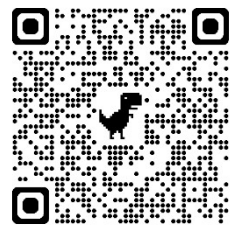
REGISTRATION for 2026-2027 RELIGIOUS EDUCATION IS NOW OPEN!

Please complete the registration form online or the paper registration at the vestibule to register your family for our family-based Faith Formation program GIFT (Generations in Faith Together), Sacramental Preparation (First Communion and/or Confirmation), OCIA Adapted for Children (for those 5th grade and above who have not yet been baptized or have not received First Communion) and our Middle School (MSYM).

Families whose children will be preparing to receive First Holy Communion must participate in GIFT as this is our primary form of faith formation for families. We believe that faith formation is a life-long endeavor, so continuous, non-interrupted participation in GIFT is recommended for families with children in Kindergarten through 8th grades.

This eight-week series begins on Monday, September 14th and is held in the St. Matthias parish hall from 10 - 11:15 AM, and repeated at 7 - 8:15 PM. No registration is necessary. Participants should bring a Bible and a pen. Bibles will also be available to borrow. The Book of Genesis is unique since it is the first book of the Bible. Through divine revelation, it takes us back before recorded history. It provides the foundation for the rest of the Old Testament and for the New Testament.
